



# JAYA ANCOL SINGLES CHAMPIONSHIP 2018

*Jaya Ancol Bowling Center, Jakarta – Indonesia*

*29 April – 5 May 2018*

## Rules and Regulations

### 1. Playing Rules

This Championship is organized by Jaya Ancol Bowling Center, sanctioned by Indonesia Bowling Federation (PBI), Asian Bowling Federation (ABF) and World Bowling. It will be conducted in accordance to the World Bowling Playing Rules.

### 2. Eligibility

This Tournament is open to all current paid up members of Indonesia Bowling Federation (PBI) and World Bowling Affiliates. All local participants must show proof by producing their membership cards for examination. All overseas participants must obtain clearance from their respective Congresses.

### 3. Averages

For members of the Indonesian Bowling Congress (PBI) only PBI's official 1st – 2018 Quarter average ranking will be used. An entrant who has no PBI's official 1st Quarter average ranking will use his/her PBI's official 4th – 2017 Quarter average ranking. An entrant who has no established average must produce written confirmation of their averages from their respective PBI-Provinces offices.

### 4. Classification

- 4.1 Open : All male and female bowlers, regardless of average, are eligible to participate in this division.
- 4.2 Classified : All male bowlers with average of 195 and below; and all female bowlers with average of 185 and below are eligible to play in this division.
- 4.3 Graded B : All male bowlers with average of 185 and below; and all female bowlers with average of 175 and below are eligible to play in this division. This division is only open for Indonesian bowlers and does not need to qualify.
- 4.4 Youth : All boys and girls who are 21 years of age and below as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2018 (born on 1997 or after) are eligible to play in this division. This division does not need to participate in the qualification round.

## 5. Events

### 5.1 Open Division

1. *Master Qualifying – total of 15 games in 3 days of qualified (each day 5 games)*
2. *Master (10 games)*

### 5.2 Classified Division

1. *Master Qualifying – total of 15 games in 3 days of qualified (each day 5 games)*
2. *Master (10 games)*

### 5.3 Graded B Division

1. *Master (10 games)*

### 5.4 Youth Division

1. *Master (8 games)*

### 5.5 Master Qualifying

1. There will be no qualifying round for the Youth and Graded B Divisions. Entrant just needs to pay an entry fee upon registration (first come first served).
2. 15 games will be bowled in the qualifying round. The total of 15 games will be listed for ranking into the Masters.

For Youth and Graded B Divisions' entrant, he/she will be able to pay an extra fee so they can participate in the qualifying round. They may enter both divisions in one attempt. They only need to bowl 15 games and the score will be used to qualify in both Classified and Open Divisions.

Same goes to Classified Division's entrant. He/she will be able to pay an extra fee so his/her score can also be used to qualify in the Open Division.

3. Desperado Squad: It is available for Open and Classified Division. One game will be bowled in this event after the last squad of qualifying. For Classified Division's entrant, he/she may enter both divisions in one attempt. He/she only needs to bowl the one game and the score will be used to qualify in both divisions.

### 5.6 Open Master

- Round I : All bowlers will bowl 15 games of qualifying in 3 blocks of 5 games. The top 45 bowlers will qualify for Round II, as follows:
1. The top 36 players of local and overseas qualifiers
  2. 4 of Indonesian qualifiers – position 37<sup>th</sup> to 40<sup>th</sup>
  3. 1 of female (in general) qualifiers – position 41<sup>st</sup>
  4. 4 of desperado qualifiers – position 42<sup>nd</sup> – 45<sup>th</sup>

- Round II : All qualifiers will bowl a total of 10 games. The top 7 bowlers will advance to the stepladder final. The stepladder final will be played in 4 steps:

1. In Step I, the 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> position bowlers will bowl one game starting from scratch. The bowler with the highest score will continue to Step II. The bowler who lost can only be dropped one position.

**Note: Rank 7 (7<sup>th</sup> Position) will be filled only by Indonesian bowler.**

2. In Step II, the winner from Step I will meet the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> position bowlers for another one game match starting from scratch. The bowler

with the highest score will continue to Step III. The bowler who lost can only be dropped one position.

3. In Step III, the winner from Step II will meet the 2<sup>nd</sup> position for another one game match starting from scratch. The bowler with the highest score will continue to Step IV.
4. In Step IV, the winner from Step III will then challenge the 1<sup>st</sup> position bowler in a one plus one game match starting from scratch. In the event that the 1<sup>st</sup> position bowler wins the first game, he/she will be declared the champion. If the 1<sup>st</sup> position bowler loses the first game, there will be one more roll-off match starting from scratch to decide the champion.

Senior	All male & female bowlers aged 50 and over (born in 1968 or before). Bowler aged 51 (born in 1967) will be given a handicap of 1 pin, and an additional 1 pin for each year from age 51 onwards with a maximum handicap 10 pins. Bowler aged 65 will be given a handicap of 10 pins. Senior bowlers will still eligible to have an additional handicap (according to their average) on top of the above.		

### 5.7 Classified Master

Round I : All bowlers will bowl 15 games of qualifying in 3 blocks of 5 games. The top 45 bowlers will qualify for Round II, as follows:

1. The top 36 players of local and overseas qualifiers
2. 4 of Indonesian qualifiers – position 37<sup>th</sup> to 40<sup>th</sup>
3. 1 of female (in general) qualifiers – position 41<sup>st</sup>
4. 4 of desperado qualifiers – position 42<sup>nd</sup> – 45<sup>th</sup>

Round II : All qualifiers will bowl a total of 10 games in the master final to decide the winners.

Senior	All male & female bowlers aged 50 and over (born in 1968 or before). Bowler aged 51 (born in 1967) will be given a handicap of 1 pin, and an additional 1 pin for each year from age 51 onwards with a maximum handicap 10 pins. Bowler aged 65 will be given a handicap of 10 pins. Senior bowlers will still eligible to have an additional handicap (according to their average) on top of the above.	

**5.8 Graded B Master:** All qualifiers (total of 72 bowlers) will bowl a total of 10 games in the master final to decide the winners. **Handicap for female per game is 8 points.**

**5.9 Youth Master:** All qualifiers (total of 72 bowlers) will bowl a total of 8 games in the master final to decide the winners.

## 6. Squad Times

If preferred squad times indicated on the entry forms are not available, the Tournament Directors or their assistants reserve the right to reallocate squad times at their discretion. The Tournament Directors reserve the right to open additional squad.

## 7. Check-in Time

Check-in will open one hour and close 30 minutes before the scheduled squad time in every event unless otherwise stated (bowlers must inform the check-in counter if they have consecutive squad booking in order to exempt the check-in procedure for following squad booking). For those who fail to check-in personally at the prescribed time, their placing as well as the fees will be forfeited. The vacancy will be allocated to next pre-booking reserved bowler.

All master qualifiers must check-in personally at the tournament desk at least 30 minutes before the schedule time for the master final, failing which they shall be disqualified and reserves shall be called. The center clock shall be the official timepiece of the tournament.

## 8. Entry Fees

Fee is including registration, qualify and master final.

### One Division Only:

## 9. Verification of Scores

It is the responsibility of each bowler and/or the team captain to verify the correctness of each game bowled by signing on the official entry sheet. Once signed, the score shall stand. Official score sheet without signature will be treated as correct and no protest can be bought against it.

## 10. Interrupted Games

10.1 Tournament Director may authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of lanes when equipment failure on the lanes would delay the normal progress

of the lanes. An interrupted game and series that cannot be completed must resume from the point of interruption.

- 10.2 In the event of score of any game is lost/erased and cannot be recalled and/or traced due to power or equipment failure, the bowler concerned will be required to re-bowl a new game when the power supply resumes or equipment is repaired. However, all scores of completed games that have been recorded in the official score sheet remain unchanged.
- 10.3 If more than one game cannot be recalled, the series shall be declared null and void and a fresh series is rescheduled.
- 10.4 If only one frame is missing, the bowler shall continue from the last frame bowled.

## **11. Bowling Balls**

- 11.1 It is the bowler's responsibility to ensure that all bowling balls used during the tournament are verified for correctness of weight and other specifications, conforming to World Bowling Rules and Regulation. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to examine the used by participants. Use of an illegal ball is ground for disqualification and forfeiture of games, prizes and standing aside from any penalties that may be imposed.
- 11.2 Altering the surface of bowling balls is **only allowed** during official practice session before a block of games or competition round. Altering surface of the bowling ball during or between games is not allowed. If the surface is adjusted **during a game, the penalty is zero pin-fall in that game.** If the surface is adjusted between games, that ball **will be taken away from the competition until that block or round of games/competition is finished.**

## **12. Registration of Bowling Ball, Illegality and Disqualification**

All participants are advised to check that their bowling balls used in the Tournament are certified as legal for weight and other specifications before they compete in their events. The onus is on the bowler to ensure that all balls he/she uses are certified legal as above.

If at any time a bowler is found to have used an illegal ball even if previously certified legal by the Tournament Office, he/she shall be disqualified from the entire Tournament and stripped of all his/her winnings or positions standing and if the Tournament Committee is of the opinion that such usage was deliberate and was intended to cheat, he/she may be further reported to the PBI Disciplinary Committee or ABF Executive Committee for additional penalization. He/she may also be asked to return immediately to one of the Tournament Directors any awards that may have already been given to him/her.

## **13. Tie-Breaking Procedure**

- 13.1 In case of a tie in qualifying for last position for master finals, a one game roll-off shall be held. The Tournament Committee will decide the time for the roll-off. If a tie still exists, a repeat of the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off will be held until the tie is broken.
- 13.2 If a tie occurs in the final or stepladder final, a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off shall be used and/or repeated until the tie is broken.

## 14. Cheating

Any bowler found guilty of cheating scores, averages eligibility or in any other counts will be immediately disqualified from the entire tournament and reported to the Disciplinary Committee of Indonesian Bowling Congress and the Asian Bowling Federation for further action. He/she will also be stripped of his/her winnings positions standing and be asked to return to the tournament Directors any awards that may have already been given to him/her. When in doubt, bowlers are reminded to consult the Tournament Directors on any issues.

## 15. Bowlers Attire

Only proper bowling uniform (Polo Shirt and Crew neck T-Shirt) and proper bowling shoes will be allowed during competition. Bowlers in singlet, sleeveless t-shirt and jeans will not allow to bowl. Female bowlers can wear skirts, shorts, pants, slacks or dress shorts. In those instances where it is established that a bowler is in breach of this rule, he/she may be suspended by the Tournament Committee from the tournament for the block of games then being played and all fees paid will not be refunded.

## 16. Slow Bowling

Bowlers, who are in readiness to step on the approach to deliver a ball, shall have the following rights and obligations:

- 16.1 They may claim right of way over anyone moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately on their left.
- 16.2 They may give right of way over anyone moving to the approach or preparing to bowl on the lane immediately on their right.
- 16.3 Players shall be ready to bowl when it is their turn and should not delay to go to the approach, when the lanes immediately adjacent to them on the left and right sides are clear.

## 17. Protest

- 17.1 **Score:** Must be submitted in writing to the tournament Directors or their assistants within 12 hours of the event. In the case of the last match of the stepladder finals of the master event, such protest, if any should be addressed to the same officials before prize presentation. No protest made after the prize presentation will be entertained.
- 17.2 **Foul:** Must be brought to the attention of the Lane Marshall before the delivery of the next ball. No complaints made after the 2<sup>nd</sup> ball has been bowled shall be entertained.
- 17.3 **Eligibility:** Must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Directors or their assistants within 24 hours of the first infringement or before the next round or prize presentation or whichever is earlier.

## 18. Smoking and Drinking

The Players must not use tobacco products, consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol while in competition; i.e. during the entire period of a block of games. In those instances where it is established that a player is in breach of this rule, he may be suspended

by the Tournament Technical Committee from the tournament for the block of games then being played.

If a bowler is caught smoking during a game, he/she will have zero pin-fall for the game currently being played. If a bowler is caught smoking in between games, he/she will have zero pin-fall for the succeeding game.

## **19.Special Notes**

The Tournament Director and Tournament Committee reserve the right to accept or reject any entry as they see fit.

Any matters arising and not covered in these Tournament Rules will be decided by the Tournament Chairman, the Tournament Directors or the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final subject only to an appeal to the PBI. Such appeal should be made in writing and within 48 hours of the decision by any of the above.

Notwithstanding the above, an appeal for the decision of the PBI may still be lodged with the Asian Zone but through the Indonesian Bowling Congress and within 30 days of the PBI Council's decision.
